## Adventure Conservation Adventures

To be presented by Carol Isaacs, Very Experienced Conservation Volunteer

Do you enjoy going beyond?

Do you like going to wild places that few other people get to see?

By engaging in Adventure Conservation you can 'go beyond' in two important ways:

- Instead of just admiring nature, you can actively support its flourishing, and
- This can take you to remote and wild places which are often difficult to access!

Carol Isaacs is an experienced Adventure Conservationist with a few stories to tell about what it is like, and how you can engage in this exciting activity.

For example, Carol has journeyed by canoe and pack raft through the depths of the Wollemi Wilderness, weeding willow trees from the banks of the Colo River. Carol has spent up to three weeks at a time walking and weeding the remotest sections of Tasmania's wild west coast in adventures supported by helicopter insertion and food drops, followed by boat and light plane extraction.

Carol is an ex school teacher and extremely experienced bush regenerator, a passionate bushwalker and conservation volunteer with a recently completed degree in Land Management.
