David is establishing the new transdisciplinary field of pyrogeography. Pyrogeography understands landscape burning from a multi-time-space-and-disciplinary perspective. Which means human, physical and biological aspects are considered at local to global scale over the geological past into the future.

David is also a bushwalker who can give us first hand insight into the future of our outdoor adventure.
